2012-2013 Annual Student Data Report Highlights

Enrollment

- The total number of full-time students enrolled in the 21 professional O.D. programs in the United States and Puerto Rico during academic year 2012-2013 is 6,555, an increase of 4.2% over last year, and an increase of 18.0% since 2007-2008. The number of full-time first-year students increased by 5.1% over last year and increased by 22.0% over the past five years. The percentage of female full-time students in the professional O.D. programs rose slightly to 64.5%, from 64.3% last year; five years ago the percentage was 64.6%. Only one school reported more full-time male students than female students in 2012-2013. (tables 1.1 and 1.2)
- The percentage of Black or African American full-time students remained steady from last year to this year at 3.0%; five years ago the percentage was 3.1%. The percentage of full-time Hispanic or Latino students increased from 4.4 % to 4.5%; five years ago the percentage was 4.6%. The percentage of full-time Asian students increased from 29.2% to 29.4%; five years ago the percentage was 24.8%. The percentage of White students decreased from 56.3% to 56.0%; five years ago the percentage was 60.3%. (table 1.3)

- This year, there are 7 part-time students enrolled in the professional O.D. program, up from 5 last year. Five years ago there were 15 part-time students. (table 1.14)
- In 2012-2013, full-time and part-time students come from every state in the U.S. and the District of Columbia, from Puerto Rico and Canada, and from 13+ foreign countries. More students reside in California than any other state, with Texas coming in second. (tables 1.17 and 1.19)

Graduates

- The total number of graduates at the schools and colleges of optometry, both regular and special programs, increased 5.4% from 2011 (1332) to 2012 (1404). (table 2.1)
- The number of graduates receiving the O.D. degree through only the regular O.D. program increased 5.7% from 2011 (1,308) to 2012 (1,383). (table 2.1)
- In 2012, 64.5% of graduates of the professional O.D. programs, both regular and special programs, were female, up from 63.6% the previous year. In 2012, there were more female graduates than male graduates at all but two schools of optometry. (table 2.2)
- The percentage of Black or African American graduates of regular and special programs in 2012 increased from 2.6% to 2.9%; in 2007 it was 3.3%. The percentage of Hispanic graduates decreased from 4.9% to 4.3%; in 2007 it was 5.5%. The percentage of Asian graduates increased from 26.1% to 27.8%; in 2007 it was 24.8%. The percentage of White graduates decreased from 58.3% to 57.3%; in 2007 it was 60.7%. (table 2.3)

Financial Aid/Student Expenses

- In 2011-2012, at least four-fifths of all students at 18 out of 20 optometry schools received financial aid. At 12 of these 20 schools, 90% or more of students received financial aid. Average awards for residents ranged from \$30,258 to \$68,735, and for non-residents from \$33,235 to \$76,344. (table 3.1)
- In 2012-2013, the average tuition for a first-year resident student enrolled in the professional O.D. program was \$18,538 at a public school and \$30,668 at a private school. The cost for all direct expenses (tuition, fees, books and instruments) for a first-year resident student was \$26,587 for a public school and \$35,913 for a private school. First-year non-residents paid an average \$35,211 for tuition and \$43,260 for all direct expenses at a public school, and \$31,639 for tuition and \$36,884 for all direct expenses at a private school.
