#### ABOUT THE ASCO ANNUAL FACULTY DATA REPORT

The 2020-2021 ASCO Annual Faculty Data Report was developed from data collected through ASCO's Annual Faculty Survey from the 23 U.S. schools and colleges of who were members of ASCO as of October 1, 2020.

The Faculty Survey opened for completion on October 6, 2020 and had a requested completion date of November 10, 2020. Schools were asked to provide information that was current as of October 1, 2020. The release date of the 2020-2021 Annual Faculty Data Report is March 2, 2021. This public report does not include tables 1-3, which contain aggregate salary information.

The Survey includes only faculty who receive pay through the school or college and are primarily contracted to provide teaching and/or scholarly service at the institution in programs leading to the professional degree (O.D.), graduate degrees (e.g. M.S., Ph.D.) and residency/fellowship certificates. Those faculty who are from affiliated facilities (i.e. V.A. hospitals, Public Health Service, military, etc.) and are not compensated by the school or college are not included in this report. Residents are not included as they are not primarily contracted to provide teaching and/or scholarly service. In addition, the chief executive officer of the optometry school or college and those faculty who hold an administrative position of greater than .75 FTE are not included.

### Highlights 2020-2021 Annual Faculty Data Report

Data presented in the 2020-2021 Annual Faculty Data Report was collected through ASCO's 2020-2021 Annual Faculty Survey. All 23 member schools in the United States participated in the survey, but only 22 schools provided faculty salary data. In order to be counted in the survey, faculty must be paid through the school or college and be contracted primarily to provide teaching or scholarly service in programs leading to the O.D. degree, graduate degrees or residency or fellowship certificates. Residents are not included in the survey nor are faculty holding an administrative position of greater than .75 full-time equivalency.

The total number of 1.0 FTE faculty increased 1.9%, from 789 to 804. Forty point seven percent (40.7%) of 1.0 FTE faculty are male and 59.3% are female. The number of male 1.0 FTE faculty decreased 1.8% and the number of female faculty increased 4.6%. (Table 5)

The percentage of 1.0 FTE faculty who are Black or African American decreased from 3.8% to 3.6%, and the percentage of Hispanic or Latino increased from at 5.1% to 5.7%. The percentage of Asian faculty decreased from 20.0% to 19.7%. The percentage of faculty who are White increased from 65.1% to 65.5%. (Table 7)

The total number of all paid faculty, including all FTEs, decreased from 1132 to 1110. (Table 5) The average age of all paid faculty decreased from 47.4 to 47.2 years. The average age of didactic 1.0 FTE professors is 60.3 years. The average age of clinical 1.0 FTE professors is 58.5 years. (Table 6)

Of the 673 1.0 FTE faculty at the 19 institutions that offer tenure, 31.9% have tenure, 16.3% are on the tenure track and 51.7% are not on the tenure track. (Table 9)

The average percentage of a full-time (as defined by the school) faculty member's salary contributed by the institution for an employee benefits package decreased from 28.9% to 28.8%. The standard work week at 18 institutions is 40 hours per week, at 4 institutions 35 hours per week and at 1 institution 37.5 hours per week. (Table 4)


Of 1.0 FTE faculty joining the schools within the last year, 38.8% came from a residency program, 24.5% from an optometry practice, 20.4% from another academic institution, 6.1% from graduate school, and 2.0% each from a post-doctoral training program, VA hospital and "other" source. The recruitment source for 4.1% of new 1.0 FTE faculty was unknown, and there were no recruits from the military or industry. (Table 11) Of the faculty who departed schools in the last year, 31.6% left to begin retirement, 12.6% to enter or reenter practice, 8.4% each to accept another academic position and to pursue a non-academic career, 7.4% for personal reasons, and 31.6% for other or unknown reasons. No faculty left in order to attend post-graduate school, participate in post-doctoral training, or because of illness or death. (Table 12)


#### Degrees Earned\* by 1.0 FTE/Full-Time Faculty



All Institutions, All Ranks Combined U.S. Schools and Colleges of Optometry





Public and Private Institutions Combined







Public and Private Institutions Combined






