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2008-2009 Annual Student Data Report Highlights

The 2008-2009 Annual Student Data Report includes 17 ASCO member schools.

Applicants

- The number of applications to the schools and colleges of optometry has increased 47% since 2003. Applications increased 6.8% over last year, with fifteen schools seeing a rise in the number of applicants. The total number of applications counts the number of applications to each school, not the number of unduplicated applicants. (table 1.1)
- As in recent years, both the OAT and a personal interview are required for admission at every school. (table 1.2)
- For the 2008 entering class, the average total science Optometry Admission Test (OAT) scores of incoming students increased at 13 schools compared with the 2007 entering class, with average scores ranging from 290 to 371. Average academic OAT scores increased at 13 schools, with average scores ranging from 290 to 361. Sixteen schools had an increase in tuition. Nine schools preferred or required that matriculants have a bachelor's degree, and 16 schools had more women in the entering class than men. Between 2007 and 2008, the average undergraduate GPA of the entering class increased at 10 of the 17 schools. Entering class average GPAs ranged from 3.05 to 3.70. (table 1.3)

Enrollment

- The total number of full-time students enrolled in the professional O.D. programs during academic year 2008-2009 is 5,595, an increase of 0.7% over the previous year, and an increase of 4.5% since 2003-2004.

The number of full-time first-year students increased by 3% over last year and increased by 4.9% over the past five years. The percentage of female full-time students in the professional O.D. programs continues to increase, rising from 60.4% in 2003-2004 to 64.7% this year. Only one school reported more full-time male students than female students in 2008-2009. (tables 2.1 and 2.2)

- The percentage of Black or African American full-time students remains about the same as last year, moving from 3.1% to 3.0%. The percentage of full-time Hispanic or Latino students changed from 4.6% to 4.5%. The percentage of full-time Asian students rose from 24.8% to 26.2%. The percentage of White students decreased from 60.3% to 59.2%. (table 2.3)
- This year, there are 21 part-time students enrolled in the professional O.D. program, up from 15 last year. There has been an average of 22 part-time students per year since 2003-2004. (table 2.14)
- In 2008-2009, full-time and part-time students come from every state in the U.S., from Puerto Rico and Canada, and from at least 21 foreign countries. More students reside in California than any other state, with Texas coming in second. (tables 2.16 and 2.18)

Graduates

- The total number of graduates at the schools and colleges of optometry, both regular and special programs, increased 1.6% in 2008 to 1,342. (table 3.2)
- The number of graduates receiving the O.D. degree through only the regular O.D. program increased 2.0% from 2007 to 2008, to 1,317. (table 3.1)

- In 2008, 64.9% of graduates of the professional O.D. programs, both regular and special programs, were female, up from 62.8% in 2007. In 2008, there were more female graduates than male graduates at all but two schools of optometry. (table 3.2)
- Blacks or African Americans make up 3.4% of graduates of regular and special programs this year, up from 3.3% last year. The percentage of Hispanic graduates decreased from 5.5% last year to 4.8% this year, while the percentage of Asian graduates decreased from 24.8% to 22.7%. The percentage of White graduates increased from 60.7% last year to 62.4% this year. (table 3.3)

Financial Aid/Student Expenses

- In 2007-2008, at least 80% of students at 17 schools and colleges of optometry received financial aid. At 8 of the schools, 90% or more of students received financial aid; in 2006-2007 this was the case at 13 schools. Average awards for residents ranged from \$25,623 to \$48,364, and for non-residents from \$29,772 to \$66,959. (table 4.1)
- In 2008-2009, the average tuition for a first-year resident student enrolled in the professional O.D. program was \$14,936 at a public school and \$24,850 at a private school. The cost for all direct expenses (tuition, fees, books and instruments) for a first-year resident student was \$21,857 for a public school and \$30,150 for a private school. First-year non-residents paid an average \$30,856 for tuition and \$37,777 for all direct expenses at a public school, and \$26,934 for tuition and \$32,233 for all direct expenses at a private school. ICO	Yes Applications for advanced standing to ICO are processed in the same manner as other applications. A candidate seeking admission to ICO with advanced standing is required to follow the traditional application procedure as outlined in the College catalog (completing an application, fulfilling all prerequisites, and submitting Optometry Admission Test results). Admission to ICO Doctor of Optometry (O.D.) program is for a full-time basis only. Official transcripts must be sent to the Admissions Office directly from each university and/or college attended, including the institution where any graduate optometric or medical education was completed. After acceptance, advanced standing may be granted based upon a course-by-course comparison between previously completed coursework and the curriculum at ICO (see Course Exemption policy). The student will receive an academic schedule reflecting any approved advanced standing, indicating all remaining courses that must be completed and time required to complete the Doctor of Optometry (O.D.) program.

6. Glossary of Terms

Glossary of Terms

Admission Data:

- Applicant:** an individual whose credentials were sufficiently complete to qualify for preliminary evaluation by an admission officer and who has paid the application fee unless the application fee was waived.
- Accepted:** accepted applicants are those who were extended an offer for admission whether they accepted the admission offer or not.
- Denied:** denied applicants are those who did not get an offer for admission and who were not placed on a waitlist or list of alternates. Denied applicants do not include those applicants who, on their own initiative, requested that their application be withdrawn.
- Enrolled:** enrolled applicants are those whose name was entered into the register of students and who remained enrolled until a specified date (the date is specified in a set of instructions for completing the survey).
- Average age:** refers to the arithmetic mean of the ages of the specified category of student; it is calculated by adding individual ages and dividing the total by the number of individuals.
- Median age:** refers to the value of the middle item when the items are arranged according to size; the mean and median age is shown for each of three groups below for students of different ages.

Enrollment Data - Full and Part-time enrollment:

Regular: Regular students are those who are currently enrolled in each class leading to the O.D. degree and taking a full-time course load.

Repeat: Repeat students are those who were previously enrolled as a regular student and not advanced to the next class. For example, a student in a second year of attendance but who is repeating enough first year courses to be considered part of the first year class. Repeat students are taking a sufficient number of credit hours to be considered a full-time student.

A repeat student is not a student who was suspended and, after re-application, admitted again as a regular student.

Part-time: Part-time student are those taking less than a full-time course load.

Transfer: Transfer students are those who have enrolled after first attending another institution of optometry.
