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2010-2011 Annual Student Data Report Highlights

(Twenty schools reporting)

Applicants

- 2010-2011 marks the first year that applicant data is being provided by OptomCAS, optometry's centralized application service. The number of applications to the schools and colleges of optometry increased 42.5% over applicants for 2009-2010, before OptomCAS was operational. Applications increased 9.7% from 2008-2009 to 2009-2010. The total number of applications counts the number of applications to each school, not the number of unduplicated applicants. (table 1.1)
- As in recent years, both the OAT and a personal interview are required for admission at every school. Fifteen schools preferred or required that matriculants have a bachelor's degree, (table 1.2)
- Seventeen schools had an increase in tuition and fees. (table 1.2)
- For the 2010 entering class, the average total science scores on the Optometry Admission Test (OAT) ranged from 292 to 365. Average academic OAT scores ranged from 298 to 353. The OAT test was recently recalibrated and scores are not comparable to previous years. (table 1.3)
- Seventeen schools had more women in the entering class than men. (table 1.3)
- Between 2009 and 2010, the average undergraduate GPA of the entering class increased at five schools. Entering class average GPAs ranged from 2.88 to 3.68. (table 1.3)

Enrollment

- The total number of full-time students enrolled in the 20 professional O.D. programs during academic year 2010-2011 is 6,060, an increase of 3.9% over last year, and an increase of 12.7% since 2005-2006. The number of full-time first-year students decreased by 0.9% over last year and increased by 16.2% over the past five years. The percentage of female full-time students in the professional O.D. programs is 63.9%, about the same as last year's 64%; five years ago the percentage was 63.1%. Two schools reported more full-time male students than female students in 2010-2011. (tables 2.1 and 2.2)
- The percentage of Black or African American full-time students decreased from 2.8% last year to 2.7% this year; five years ago the percentage was 3.5%. The percentage of full-time Hispanic or Latino students increased from 4.4 % to 4.5%; five years ago the percentage was 5.1%. The percentage of full-time Asian students rose from 27.5% to 28.2%; five years ago the percentage was 23.3%. The percentage of White students decreased from 57.3% to 56.5%; five years ago the percentage was 63.2%. (table 2.3)
- This year, there are 4 part-time students enrolled in the professional O.D. program, down from 15 last year and 21 the year before. Five years ago there were 22 part-time students. (table 2.14)
- In 2010-2011, full-time and part-time students come from every state in the U.S., from Puerto Rico and Canada, and from 17+ foreign countries. As was the case last year, more students reside in California than any other state, with Texas coming in second. (tables 2.16 and 2.18)

Graduates

- The total number of graduates at the schools and colleges of optometry, both regular and special programs, remained about the same from 2009 (1,357) to 2010 (1,356) (table 3.2)

- The number of graduates receiving the O.D. degree through only the regular O.D. program decreased 0.2% from 2009 (1,327) to 2010 (1,325). (table 3.1)
- In 2010, 64.7% of graduates of the professional O.D. programs, both regular and special programs, were female, holding about steady from the previous year. In 2010, there were more female graduates than male graduates at all but one school of optometry. (table 3.2)
- The percentage of Black or African American graduates of regular and special programs in 2010 remained at 2.7%; five years ago it was 3.2%. The percentage of Hispanic graduates decreased from 4.9% to 4.1%; five years ago it was 5.2%. The percentage of Asian graduates increased from 23.0% to 26.9%; five years ago it was 25.4%. The percentage of White graduates decreased from 63.2% to 59.1%; five years ago it was 61.4%. (table 3.3)

Financial Aid/Student Expenses

- In 2009-2010, more than four-fifths of all students at 19 out of 20 optometry schools received financial aid. At 10 of the schools, 90% or more of students received financial aid; in 2008-2009 this was the case at nine schools. Average awards for residents ranged from \$28,105 to \$58,320, and for non-residents from \$29,688 to \$69,186. (table 4.1)
- In 2010-2011, the average tuition for a first-year resident student enrolled in the professional O.D. program was \$17,511 at a public school and \$28,192 at a private school. The cost for all direct expenses (tuition, fees, books and instruments) for a first-year resident student was \$24,140 for a public school and \$33,076 for a private school. First-year non-residents paid an average \$34,709 for tuition and \$41,338 for all direct expenses at a public school, and \$29,208 for tuition and \$34,092 for all direct expenses at a private school. Admission of Students with Advanced Standing to the Professional O.D. Program, AY 2010-2011

School ID	The following schools have a policy which permits admission of students with advanced standing (excluding graduates of foreign schools) at a second, third or fourth year level.
AZCOPT	AZCOPT may elect to accept transfer students from other U.S. accredited schools of optometry for students who remain in good academic standing and provide acceptable reason(s) for seeking transfer. Typically, students will transfer at the beginning of the second year of the curriculum. Students requesting transfers must meet the College's general requirements for admission and submit all required application materials. The transfer application must be received sufficiently early to allow for processing of the application, interview, and moving of the student prior to the start of the next academic term.
ICO	Applications for advanced standing to the Illinois College of Optometry are processed in the same manner as other applications. A candidate seeking admission to the Illinois College of Optometry with advanced standing is required to follow the traditional application procedure as outlined on ICO's website (completing an application, fulfilling all prerequisites, and submitting Optometry Admission Test results). After acceptance to the College, advanced standing may be granted based upon a course-by-course comparison between previously completed coursework and the curriculum at the Illinois College of Optometry. The student will receive an academic schedule reflecting any approved advanced standing, indicating all remaining courses that must be completed and time required to complete the Doctor of Optometry (O.D.) program.
NSUOCO	NSUOCO endorses the policy, approved and adopted by ASCO in 1992, regarding student transfer from another school or college of optometry. The concept of that policy is that student continuity at a single institution in the professional program is, most often, in the best interest of the student. The student's reason for transfer must be compelling and directly related to his or her ability to complete an O.D. degree.
PCO	Candidates who have been accepted and matriculated into the full four-year Doctor of Optometry program can request review for advanced standing. Candidates are considered on an individual basis and are required to complete a minimum of three years at Pennsylvania College of Optometry at Salus University.
PUCO	We accept qualified transfer students from other accredited schools or colleges of optometry. Transcripts for those students are evaluated on an individual basis, and they are given a customized curriculum based on previous completed coursework.
SCCO	Only after 1 year, considered on individual basis, must be academically competitive and have a compelling reason
SCO	Most students accepted for transfer are required to repeat all or most coursework and usually begin as a first-year, first-semester student. However, once an application for transfer has been submitted along with all required documentation, the VP for Academic Affairs will determine if advanced standing is warranted, and, if so, at what level in the program the student would be placed if admitted.
SUNY	SUNY Optometry evaluates the credentials of potential transfer students to determine if, and at what level, the students will be placed in the professional OD program.
UMSL	Individually based.

6. Glossary of Terms

Glossary of Terms

Admission Data:

- Applicant:** an individual whose credentials were sufficiently complete to qualify for preliminary evaluation by an admission officer and who has paid the application fee unless the application fee was waived.
- Accepted:** accepted applicants are those who were extended an offer for admission whether they accepted the admission offer or not.
- Denied:** denied applicants are those who did not get an offer of admission and who were not placed “on hold” or on a list of alternates. Denied applicants do not include those applicants who, on their own initiative, requested that their application be withdrawn.
- Enrolled:** enrolled applicants are those whose name was entered into the register of students and who remained enrolled until a specified date (the date is specified in a set of instructions for completing the survey).
- Average age:** refers to the arithmetic mean of the ages of the specified category of student; it is calculated by adding individual ages and dividing the total by the number of individuals.
- Median age:** refers to the value of the middle item when the items are arranged according to size; the mean and median age is shown for each of three groups below for students of different ages.

Enrollment Data - Full and Part-time enrollment:

Regular: Regular students are those who are currently enrolled in each class leading to the O.D. degree and taking a full-time course load.

Repeat: Repeat students are those who were previously enrolled as a regular student and not advanced to the next class. For example, a student in a second year of attendance but who is repeating enough first year courses to be considered part of the first year class. Repeat students are taking a sufficient number of credit hours to be considered a full-time student.

A repeat student is not a student who was suspended and, after re-application, admitted again as a regular student.

Part-time: Part-time student are those taking less than a full-time course load.

Transfer: Transfer students are those who have enrolled after first attending another institution of optometry.
