ABOUT THE ASCO ANNUAL FACULTY DATA REPORT

The 2021-2022 ASCO Annual Faculty Data Report was developed from data collected through ASCO's Annual Faculty Survey from the 23 U.S. schools and colleges of optometry who were members of ASCO as of October 1, 2021.

The Faculty Survey opened on October 5, 2021 for two weeks, then reopened on November 15 with a requested completion date of December 20, 2021. Schools were asked to provide information that was current as of October 1, 2021. The release date of the 2021-2022 Annual Faculty Data Report is March 21, 2022. This public report does not include tables 1 – 3, which contain aggregate salary information.

The Survey includes only faculty who receive pay through the school or college and are primarily contracted to provide teaching and/or scholarly service at the institution in programs leading to the professional degree (O.D.), graduate degrees (e.g. M.S., Ph.D.) and residency/fellowship certificates. Those faculty who are from affiliated facilities (i.e. V.A. hospitals, Public Health Service, military, etc.) and are not compensated by the school or college are not included in this report. Residents are not included as they are not primarily contracted to provide teaching and/or scholarly service. In addition, the chief executive officer of the optometry school or college and those faculty who hold an administrative position of greater than .75 FTE are not included.

Highlights

2021-2022 Annual Faculty Data Report

Data presented in the 2021-2022 Annual Faculty Data Report was collected through ASCO's 2021-2022 Annual Faculty Survey. All 23 member schools in the United States participated in the survey. In order to be counted in the survey, faculty must be paid through the school or college and be contracted primarily to provide teaching or scholarly service in programs leading to the O.D. degree, graduate degrees or residency or fellowship certificates. Residents are not included in the survey nor are faculty holding an administrative position of greater than .75 full-time equivalency.

The total number of 1.0 FTE faculty decreased 1.4% since last year, from 804 to 793. Thirty-nine point six (39.6%) of 1.0 FTE faculty are male and 60.4% are female. The number of male 1.0 FTE faculty decreased 4.0% and the number of female faculty increased 0.4%. (Table 5)

The percentage of 1.0 FTE faculty who are Black or African American increased from 3.6% to 3.8%, and the percentage of Hispanic or Latino increased from 5.7% to 5.8%. The percentage of Asian faculty increased from 19.7% to 20.6%. The percentage of faculty who are White decreased from 65.5% to 64.3%. (Table 7)

The total number of all paid faculty, including all FTEs, decreased from 1110 to 1100. (Table 5) The average age of all paid faculty decreased from 47.2 to 47.1 years. The average age of didactic 1.0 FTE professors is 59.0 years and the average age of clinical 1.0 FTE professors is 53.5 years. (Table 6)

Of the 663 1.0 FTE faculty at the 19 institutions that offer tenure, 31.8% have tenure, 14.3% are on the tenure track and 53.8% are not on the tenure track. (Table 9)

The average percentage of a full-time (as defined by the school) faculty member's salary contributed by the institution for an employee benefits package increased from 28.8% to 31.9%. The standard work week at 19 institutions is 40 hours per week, at 3 institutions 35 hours per week and at 1 institution 37.5 hours per week. (Table 4)

Of 1.0 FTE faculty joining the schools within the last year, 40.5% came from a residency program, 23.8% from another academic institution, 7.1% from an optometry practice, and 4.8% each from a graduate program and "other" source. The recruitment source for 19.0% of new 1.0 FTE faculty was unknown, and there were no recruits from the military, industry, post-doctoral training programs or VA hospitals. (Table 11) Of the faculty who departed schools in the last year, 28.7% left to begin retirement, 12.6% each to enter or reenter practice, accept another academic position and for personal reasons, 8.0% to pursue a non-academic career, 3.4% because of illness or death, 2.2% to attend post-graduate school or participate in post-doctoral training, and 19.5% for other or unknown reasons. 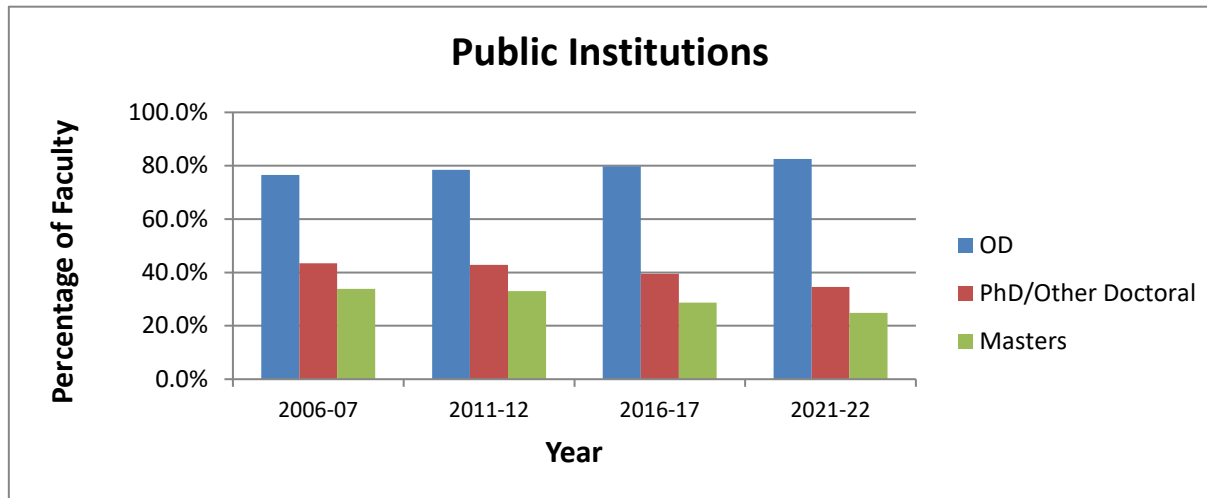
Faculty Data Trends

Degrees Earned* by 1.0 FTE/Full-Time Faculty

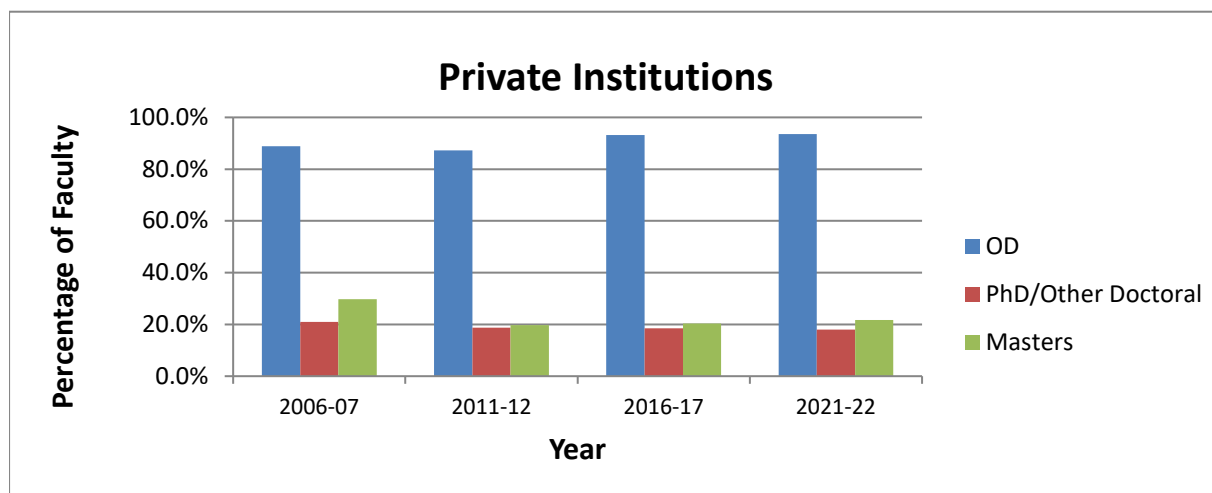

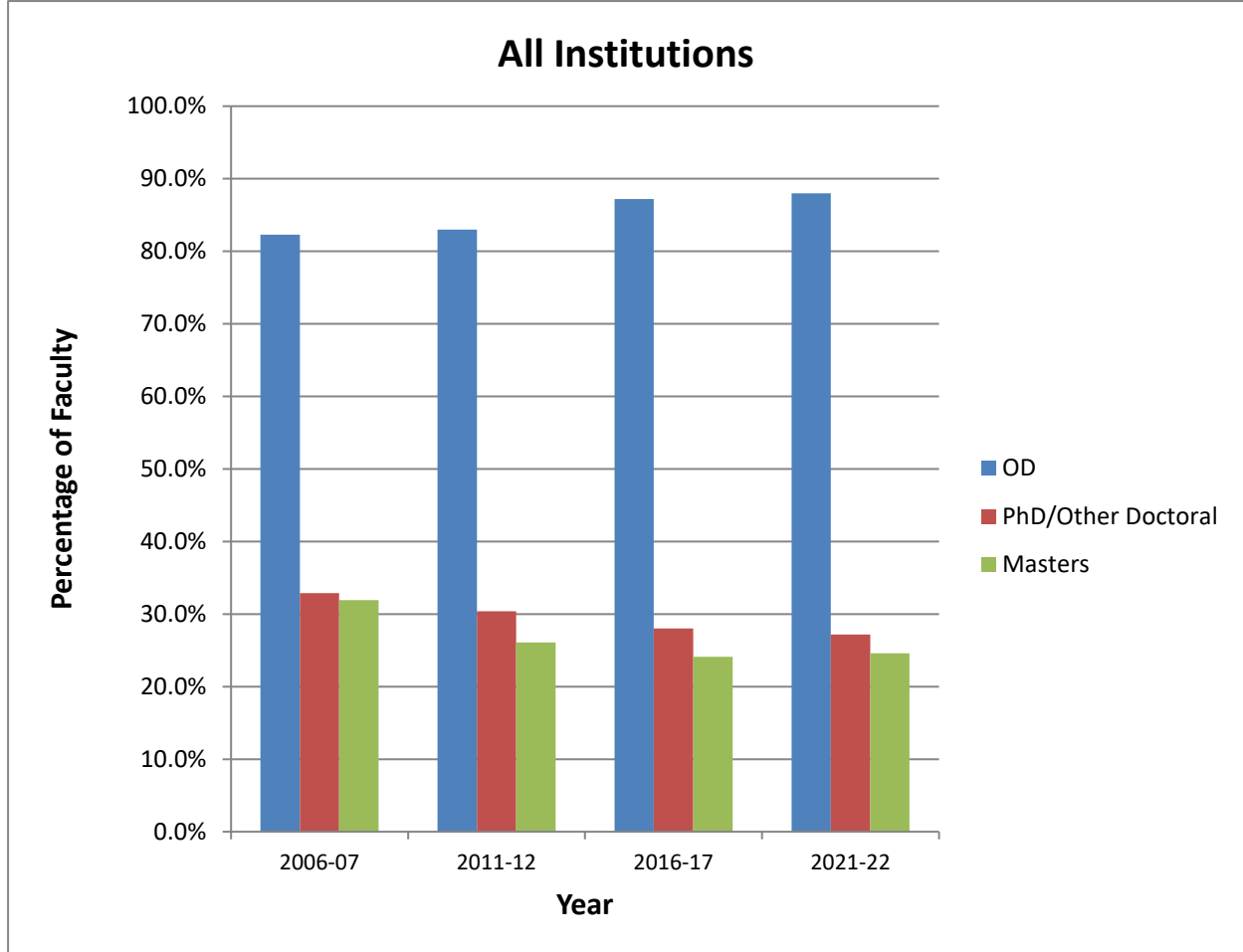

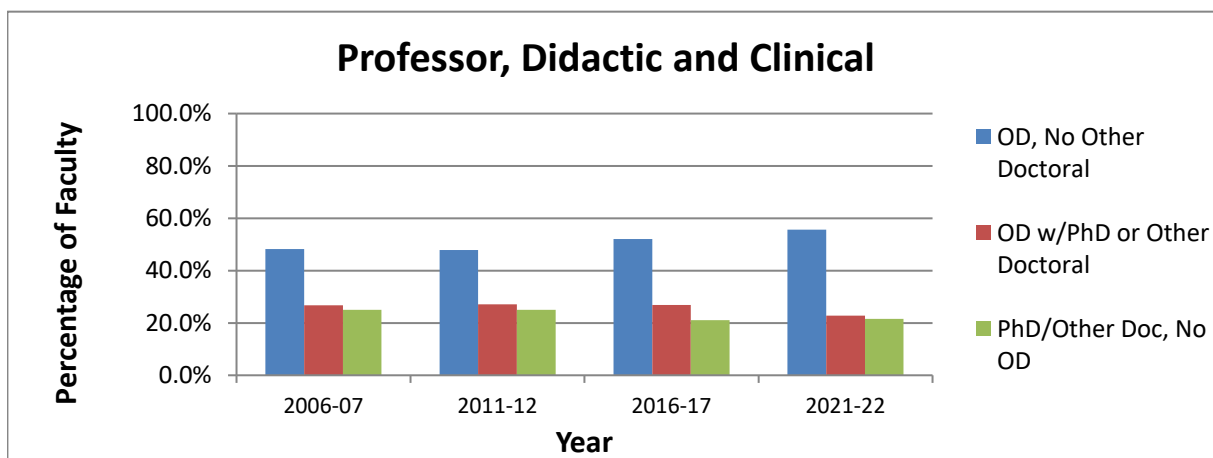

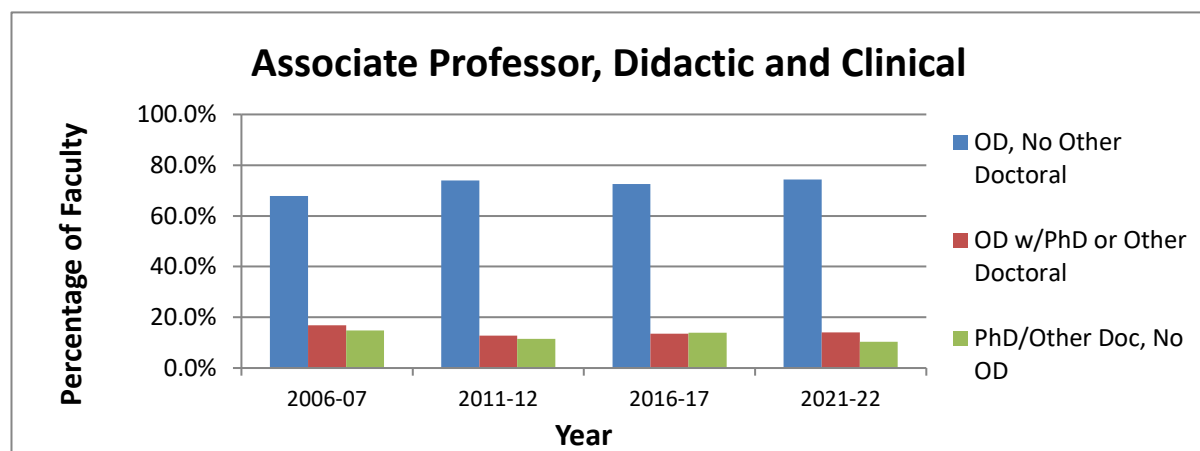

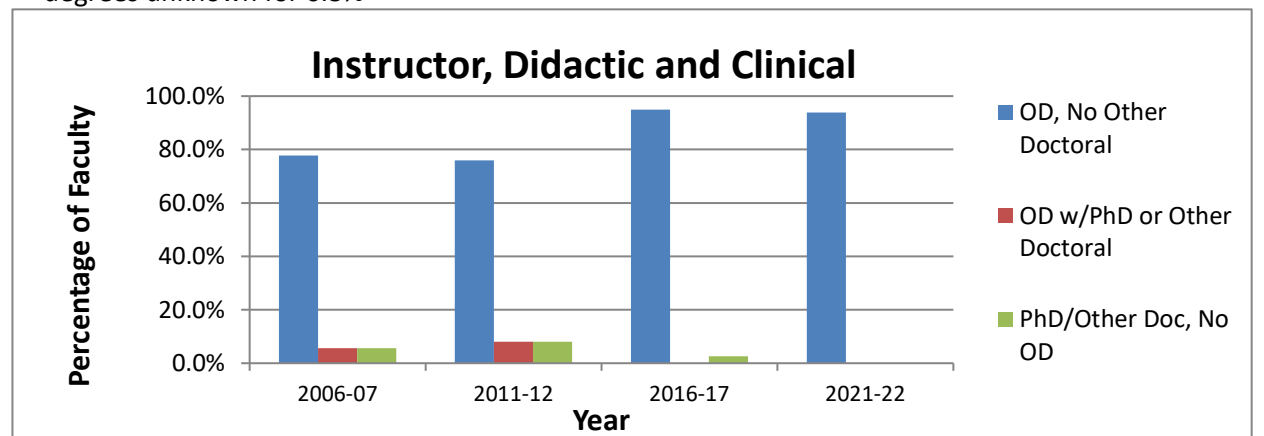

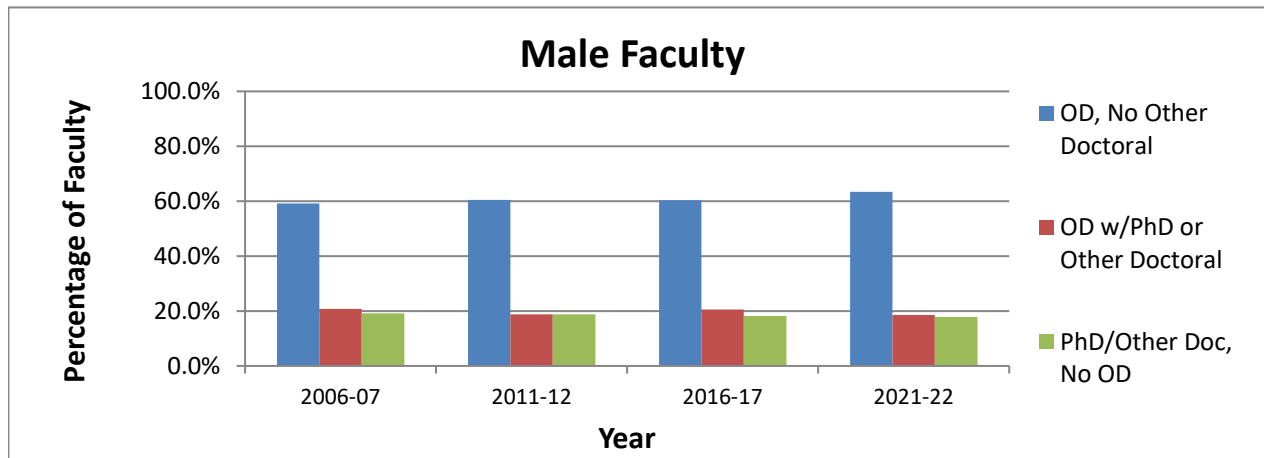

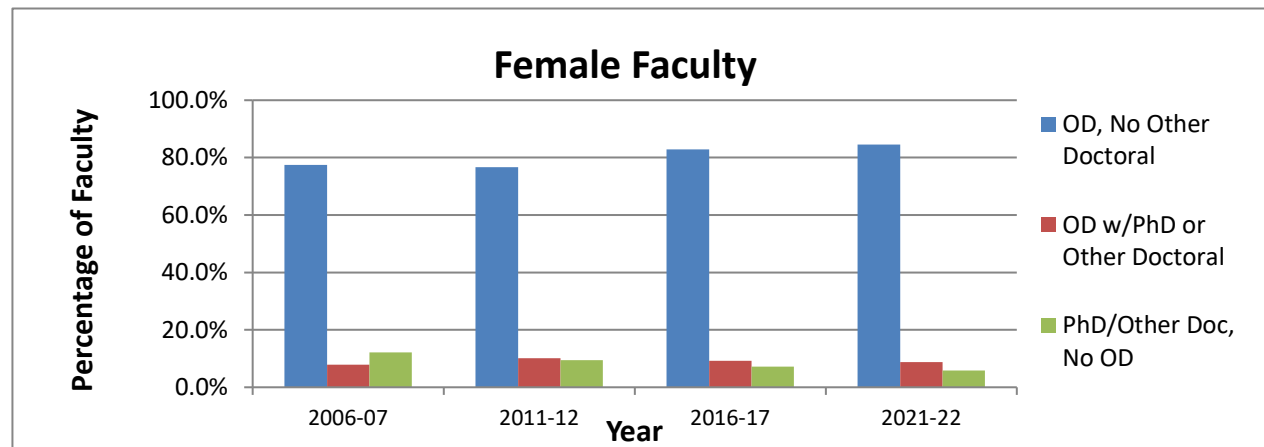
Degrees Earned by 1.0 FTE/Full-Time Faculty by Gender
