


Q3 Are you Hispanic or Latino?


Q4 Which of the following best describes your race? (Please mark one or more races.)


Q5 What is your US citizenship status?


Q6 What is your marital status?


Q7 Which of your parents completed a 4-year degree?




Q9 Which region of the United States do you consider to be your permanent residence?

Q10 What is your highest level of education?






Q12 What was the approximate size of your undergraduate institutution?




Q14 What is your undergraduate indebtedness level?


Q15 How much assistance did you receive from your health professions advisor at your undergraduate institution?


Q16 At your undergraduate campus, did you belong to a pre-optometry club, pre-health club, or pre-med club?




Q18 When did you first think about optometry as a potential career? (Please check one.)










Q24 Why didn't you choose another health profession as your future career? (Check all that apply.)








Q29 How important were the following resources to you as you chose optometry as your future career?


Q31 How many times did you apply to optometry school before being accepted?


Q32 To how many schools of optometry did you apply this year?


Q33 From how many schools of optometry did you receive acceptance?

Q34 What was your highest Academic Average OAT score?









Q45 How useful was the on-site interview in choosing which optometry school to attend?





Q46 What do you estimate your debt level will be for optometry school? (Do not include any debt for your undergraduate education.)








