ABOUT THE ASCO ANNUAL FACULTY DATA REPORT

The 2023-2024 ASCO Annual Faculty Data Report was developed from data collected through ASCO's Annual Faculty Survey from the 24 U.S. schools and colleges of optometry who were members of ASCO as of October 1, 2023.

The Faculty Survey opened for completion on October 5, 2023 and had a requested completion date of November 15, 2023. Schools were asked to provide information that was current as of October 1, 2023. The release date of the 2023-2024 Annual Faculty Data Report is February 28, 2023. This public report does not include tables 1-3, which contain aggregate salary information.

The Survey includes only faculty who receive pay through the school or college and are primarily contracted to provide teaching and/or scholarly service at the institution in programs leading to the professional degree (O.D.), graduate degrees (e.g. M.S., Ph.D.) and residency/fellowship certificates. Those faculty who are from affiliated facilities (i.e. V.A. hospitals, Public Health Service, military, etc.) and are not compensated by the school or college are not included in this report. Residents are not included as they are not primarily contracted to provide teaching and/or scholarly service. In addition, the chief executive officer of the optometry school or college and those faculty who hold an administrative position of greater than .75 FTE are not included.

Highlights 2023-2024 Annual Faculty Data Report

Data presented in the 2023-2024 Annual Faculty Data Report was collected through ASCO's 2023-2024 Annual Faculty Survey. All 24 U.S. member schools participated in the survey. In order to be counted in the survey, faculty must be paid through the school or college and be contracted primarily to provide teaching or scholarly service in programs leading to the O.D. degree, graduate degrees or residency or fellowship certificates. Residents are not included in the survey nor are faculty holding an administrative position of greater than .75 full-time equivalency.

The total number of 1.0 FTE faculty increased 0.6%, from 800 to 805. Thirty-nine point nine percent of 1.0 FTE faculty are male, 59.9% are female, and 0.2% are non-binary. The number of male 1.0 FTE faculty increased 2.9% and the number of female faculty decreased 0.8%. (Table 5)

The percentage of 1.0 FTE faculty who are Black or African American decreased from 3.9% to 3.2%, and the percentage of Hispanic or Latino increased from 5.0% to 5.1%. The percentage of Asian faculty increased from 21.4% to 21.7%. The percentage of faculty who are White increased from 63.0% to 63.2%. (Table 7)

The total number of all paid faculty, including all FTEs, increased from 1107 to 1162. (Table 5) The average age of all paid faculty increased from 47.0 to 47.4 years. The average age of didactic 1.0 FTE professors is 58.3 years and the average age of clinical 1.0 FTE professors is 55.4 years. (Table 6)

Of the 670 1.0 FTE faculty at the 19 institutions that offer tenure, 29.0% have tenure, 16.7% are on the tenure track and 54.3% are not on the tenure track. (Table 9)

The average percentage of a full-time (as defined by the school) faculty member's salary contributed by the institution for an employee benefits package increased from 28.0% to 29.3%. The standard work week at 20 institutions is 40 hours per week, at 3 institutions 35 hours per week and at 1 institution 37.5 hours per week. (Table 4)

Of 1.0 FTE faculty joining the schools within the last year, 28.6% came from a residency program and 28.6% from an optometry practice. Twenty-two point two percent came from another academic institution, 6.3% from graduate school, 4.8% from post-doctoral training, 3.2% each from the military and "other" categories, 1.6% from V.A. hospitals and none from industry. The recruitment source for 1.6% of new 1.0 FTE faculty was unknown. (Table 11) Of the faculty who departed schools in the last year, 18.9% left to pursue a non-academic career, 17.6% to enter or reenter practice, 16.2% to begin retirement, 9.5% to accept another academic position, 5.4% for personal reasons, 2.7% became deceased, 1.4% to participate in post-doctoral training, 0% to attend post-graduate school or because of illness and 28.4% for other or unknown reasons. 

Degrees Earned* by 1.0 FTE/Full-Time Faculty









Public and Private Institutions Combined







Public and Private Institutions Combined






