The MPH program consists of a Community Health concentration with an overview of the five core disciplines of public health: Biostatistics, Epidemiology, Environmental Health Science, Health Policy and Management, and Social and Behavioral Sciences. Optometrists with an MPH could develop, administer, and evaluate eye and vision health programs and participate in and provide leadership to health-related agencies that foster public awareness of the need for eye and vision care. NECO New England College of Optometry	Y	The Master of Science in Vision Science emphasizes hypothesis driven research and the development of analytical and problem solving skills in experimental vision science. The MS program requires the completion of graduate courses, execution of an original research project, and completion of a thesis. NECO offers both a stand-alone MS and a combined OD/MS program.	Y	The VA Boston Optometric Research Fellowship is a two-year, post-residency fellowship involving research, advanced clinical activities and graduate level coursework. The "interprofessional Polytrauma/TBI Rehabilitation Fellowship" is a new program open to optometrists but not exclusive to optometry, with the option of choosing a two-year research/clinical program OR a one-year clinical program. The purpose of this fellowship is to develop clinicians and scientists with knowledge and commitment to lead polytrauma and TBI efforts throughout VA, the nation, and the world.

Y	1) SUNY Optometry offers microcredentials in six areas: low vision/ocular disease, vision rehabilitation, cornea and contact lenses, glaucoma, pediatrics, and myopia management. (Important to note: the microcredentials are not accredited certificate programs). 2) Qualified students working toward their OD degree may apply for the Advanced Graduate Certificate in Optometry Business Management. The certificate is offered jointly by the College and SUNY Empire State College.

The MS may be completed in as little time as 16 months and the PhD in 33 months.
