ABOUT THE ASCO ANNUAL FACULTY DATA REPORT

The 2025-2026 ASCO Annual Faculty Data Report was developed from data collected through ASCO's Annual Faculty Survey from the 25 U.S. schools and colleges of optometry who were members of ASCO as of October 1, 2025.

The Faculty Survey opened for completion on October 13, 2025 and had a requested completion date of November 21, 2025. Schools were asked to provide information that was current as of October 1, 2025. The release date of the 2025-2026 Annual Faculty Data Report is February 26, 2026. This public report does not include tables 1 – 3, which contain aggregate salary information.

The Survey includes only faculty who receive pay through the school or college and are primarily contracted to provide teaching and/or scholarly service at the institution in programs leading to the professional degree (O.D.), graduate degrees (e.g. M.S., Ph.D.) and residency/fellowship certificates. Those faculty who are from affiliated facilities (i.e. V.A. hospitals, Public Health Service, military, etc.) and are not compensated by the school or college are not included in this report. Residents are not included as they are not primarily contracted to provide teaching and/or scholarly service. In addition, the chief executive officer of the optometry school or college and those faculty who hold an administrative position of greater than .75 FTE are not included.

Highlights

2025-2026 Annual Faculty Data Report

Data presented in the 2025-2026 Annual Faculty Data Report was collected through ASCO's 2025-2026 Annual Faculty Survey. All 25 U.S. member schools participated in the survey. In order to be counted in the survey, faculty must be paid through the school or college and be contracted primarily to provide teaching or scholarly service in programs leading to the O.D. degree, graduate degrees or residency or fellowship certificates. Residents are not included in the survey nor are faculty holding an administrative position of greater than .75 full-time equivalency.

The total number of 1.0 FTE faculty increased 2.1%, from 814 to 831. Male faculty compose 38.9% of 1.0 FTE faculty, with the balance consisting of 60.8% female and 0.4% non-binary faculty. The number of male 1.0 FTE faculty decreased 0.9% and the number of female faculty increased 3.9%. (Table 5)

The percentage of 1.0 FTE faculty who are Black or African American increased from 3.3% to 3.5%, and the percentage of Hispanic or Latino remained at 5.2%. The percentage of Asian faculty decreased from 22.0% to 21.4%. The percentage of faculty who are White increased from 62.5% to 62.9%. (Table 7)

The total number of all paid faculty, including all FTEs, increased from 1180 to 1202. (Table 5) The average age of all paid faculty remained at 47.8 years. The average age of didactic 1.0 FTE professors is 59.5 years and the average age of clinical 1.0 FTE professors is 56.7 years. (Table 6)

Of the 687 1.0 FTE faculty at the 19 institutions that offer tenure, 25.2% have tenure, 16.7% are on the tenure track and 58.1% are not on the tenure track. (Table 9)

The average percentage of a full-time (as defined by the school) faculty member's salary contributed by the institution for an employee benefits package increased from 29.5% to 29.7%. The standard work week at 21 institutions is 40 hours per week, at 3 institutions 35 hours per week and at 1 institution 37.5 hours per week. (Table 4)

Of 1.0 FTE faculty joining the schools within the last year, 31.4% came from a residency program, 15.7% from another academic institution, 14.3% from an optometry practice, 7.1% from graduate school, 4.3% from industry, 4.3% from post-doctoral training, 1.4% from V.A. hospitals, 1.4% from the military and 7.1% from "other" categories. The source for 12.9% of new 1.0 FTE faculty was unknown. (Table 11) Of the faculty who departed schools in the last year, 19.2% left to begin retirement, 17.9% to accept another academic position, 17.9% for personal reasons, 16.7% to enter or reenter practice, 9.0% to pursue a non-academic career, 0% to attend post-graduate school or participate in post-doctoral training, 0% because of illness or death, and 19.2% for other or unknown reasons. 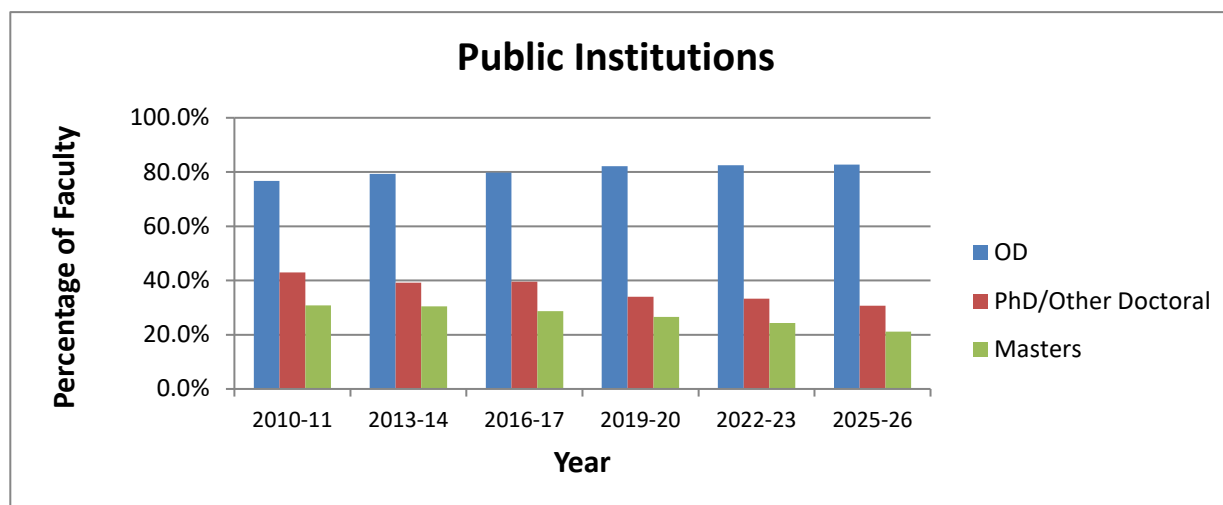

Degrees Earned* by 1.0 FTE/Full-Time Faculty

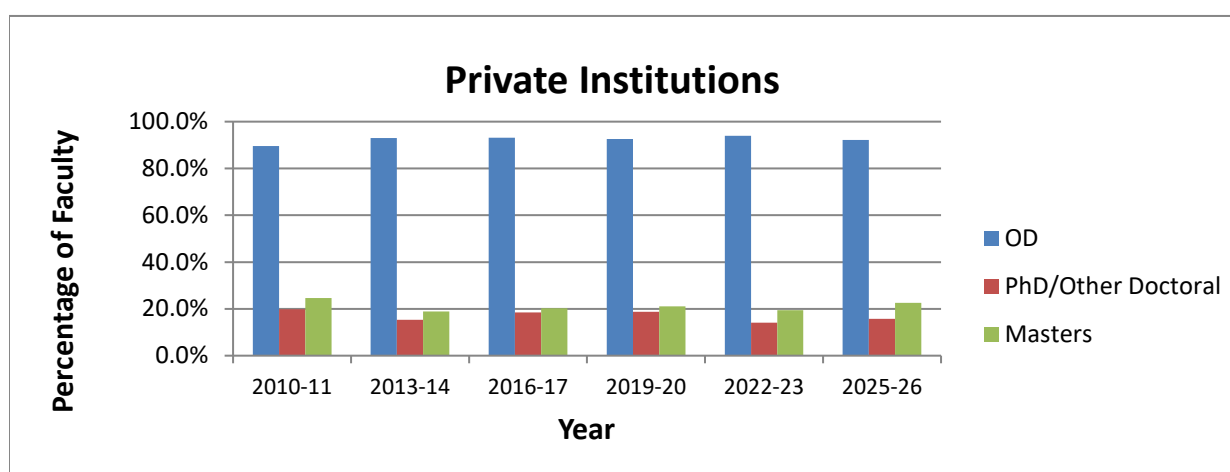

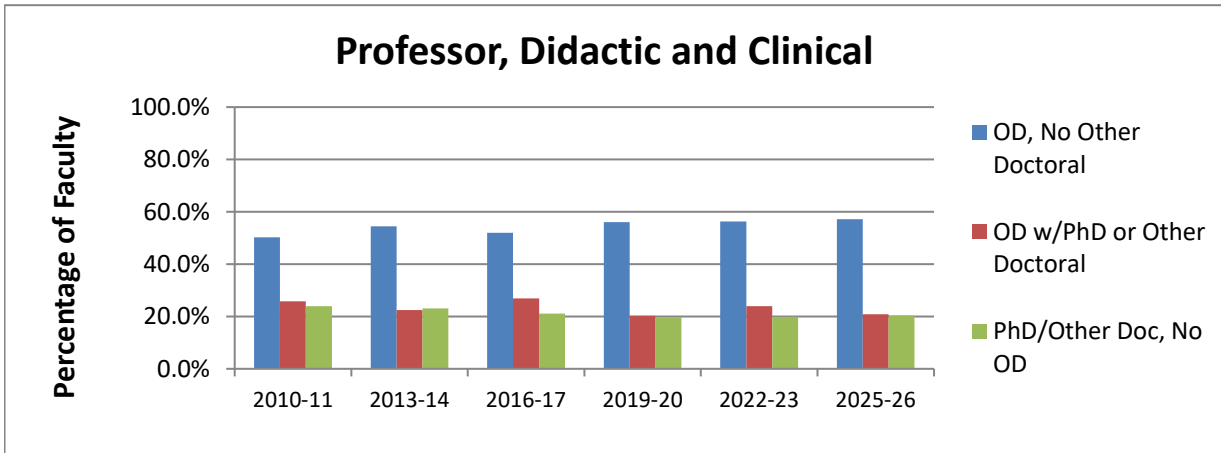

Public and Private Institutions Combined



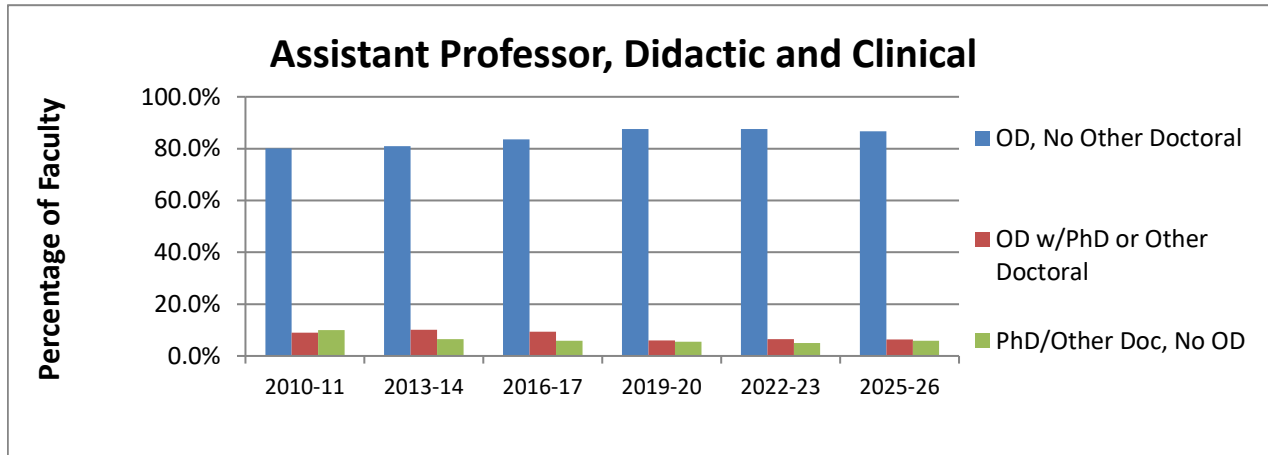

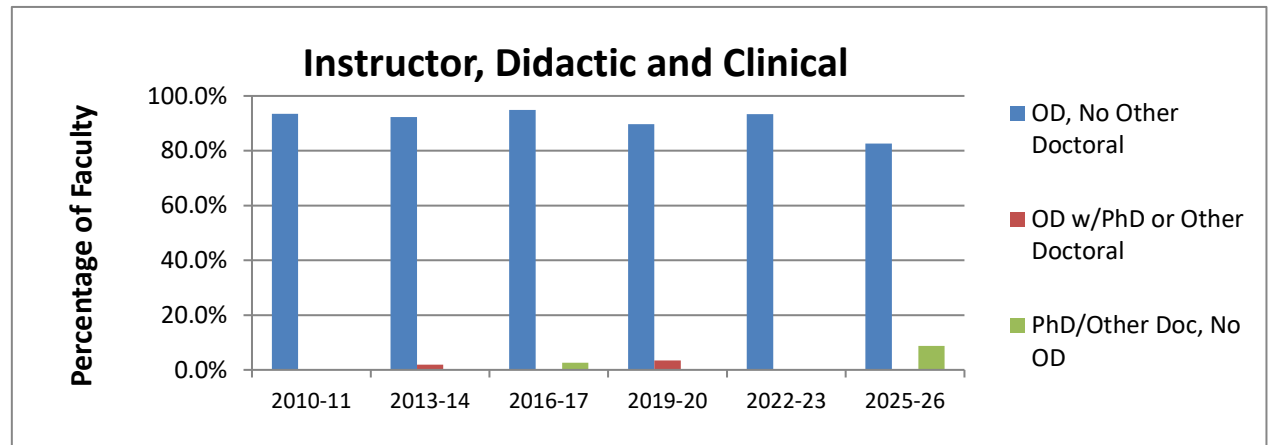
Degrees Earned by 1.0 FTE/Full-Time Faculty

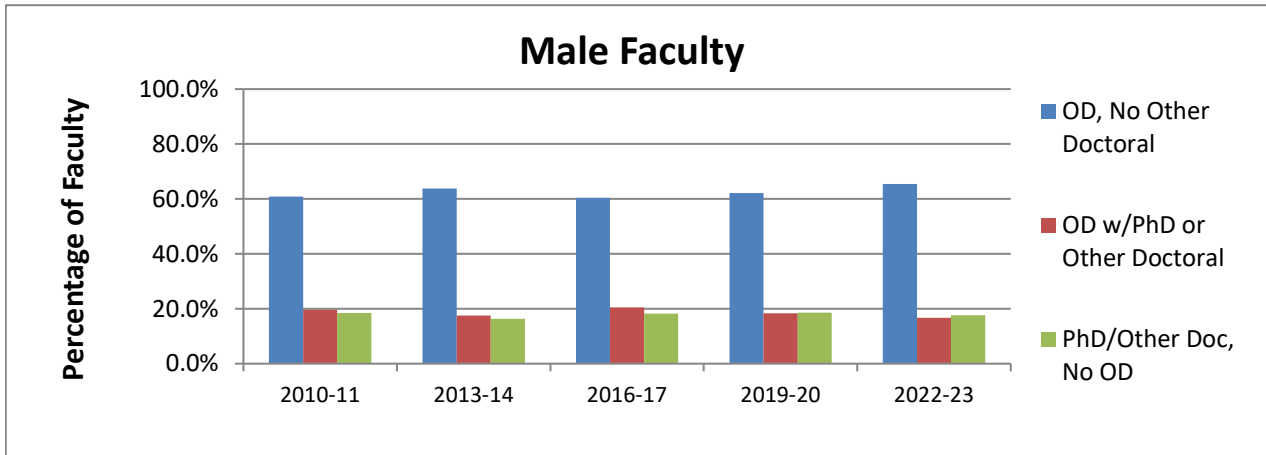

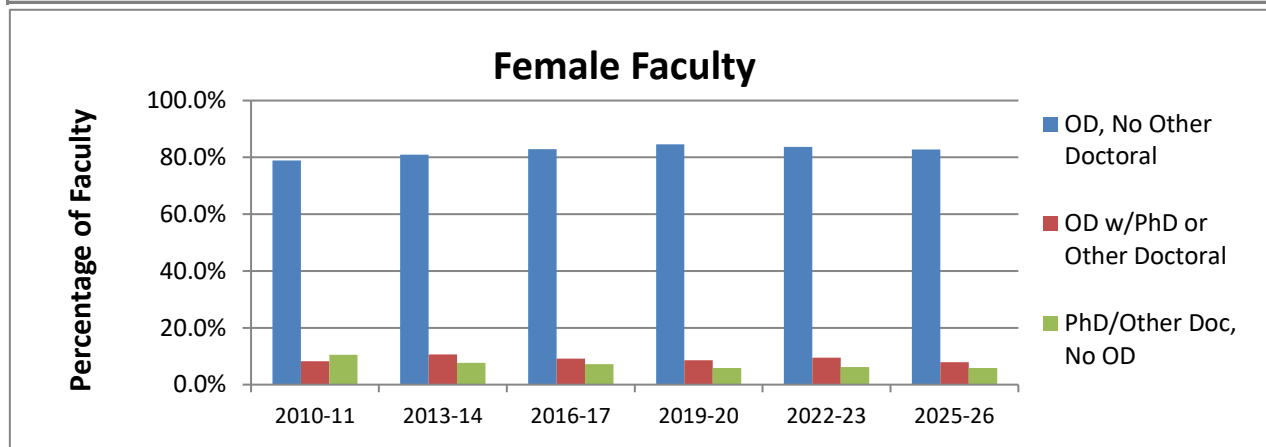
