2025-2026 Annual Student Data Report

Highlights

ASCO's 2025-2026 Annual Student Survey opened for completion on October 9, 2025, with a requested completion date of November 13, 2025. Data was collected from all 25 U.S. professional O.D. programs with enrolled students as of fall 2025.

Enrollment

- The number of full-time students as of fall 2025 was 7368, an increase of 1.7% from last year (7247) and 0.4% from five years ago (7339). The number of full-time first-year students increased 1.6% from last year and 4.3% since 2020-2021. The percentage of female full-time students in the full-time professional O.D. programs went from 70.8% to 70.7%; five years ago the percentage was 68.5%. Every school reported more full-time female students than male students in 2025-2026. (tables 1.1 and 1.2) There were an additional 180 students enrolled in part-time, alternate and special programs leading to the O.D. degree, up from 167 last year. (table 1.16)
- The percentage of full-time Black or African American students fell to 3.8%; last year it was 4.1% and five years ago it was 3.4%. The percentage of full-time Hispanic or Latino students went from 9.4% to 9.3%; five years ago the percentage was 7.2%. The percentage of full-time Asian students decreased from 30.5% to 29.7%; five years ago the percentage was 29.3%. The percentage of White students decreased from 46.9% to 46.1%; five years ago the percentage was 51.2%. The percentage of students classified as two or more races rose to 5.0% from 4.2% last year: five years ago it was 3.5%. (table 1.3)
- There were 32 part-time students enrolled in the professional O.D. program; last year there were 39 and five years ago there were 31. (table 1.14)
- In 2025-2026, full-time and part-time students came from every state in the U.S. and from the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico, from Canada and from 27 other foreign countries. More students resided in California than any other state, with the next largest group coming from Texas, followed by Canada. (tables 1.18 and 1.20)

Graduates

- The total number of graduates at the schools and colleges of optometry, from both regular and special programs, decreased 4.4% from 2024 to 2025, falling from 1791 to 1712, with 23 schools awarding degrees. The number of graduates from regular and special programs has decreased 0.8% since 2020, when there were 22 schools awarding degrees. (table 2.1)
- The number of graduates receiving the O.D. degree through only the regular O.D. program decreased 5.3% from 2024 to 2025, moving from 1748 to 1656. The number of graduates from regular O.D. programs has decreased 2.0% since 2020. (table 2.1)
- In 2025, 71.4% of graduates of the professional O.D. programs, both regular and special programs, were female, up from 69.9% the previous year. In 2020, 70.7% of graduates were female. In 2025, there were more female graduates than male graduates at all schools. (table 2.2)
- The percentage of Black or African American graduates of regular and special programs increased from 3.9% in 2024 to 5.0% in 2025; in 2020 it was 3.3%. The percentage of Hispanic graduates remained 7.9%; in 2020 it was 7.3%. The percentage of Asian graduates decreased from 30.3% to 28.3%; in 2020 it was 30.4%. The percentage of White graduates decreased from 52.7% to 48.9%; in 2020 it was 50.3%. The percentage of graduates classified as two or more races increased from 2.2% to 6.1%. In 2020 it was 2.4%. (table 2.3)
- The percentage of graduates of both regular and special O.D. programs with a permanent residence in the U.S. or in U.S. territories increased from 91.1% last year to 92.1%, with 7.5% from Canada (last year 8.0%) and 0.4% from other countries (last year 0.9%). In 2020 the figures were 91.7%, 7.4% and 0.9%. (table 2.4)

Financial Aid/Student Expenses

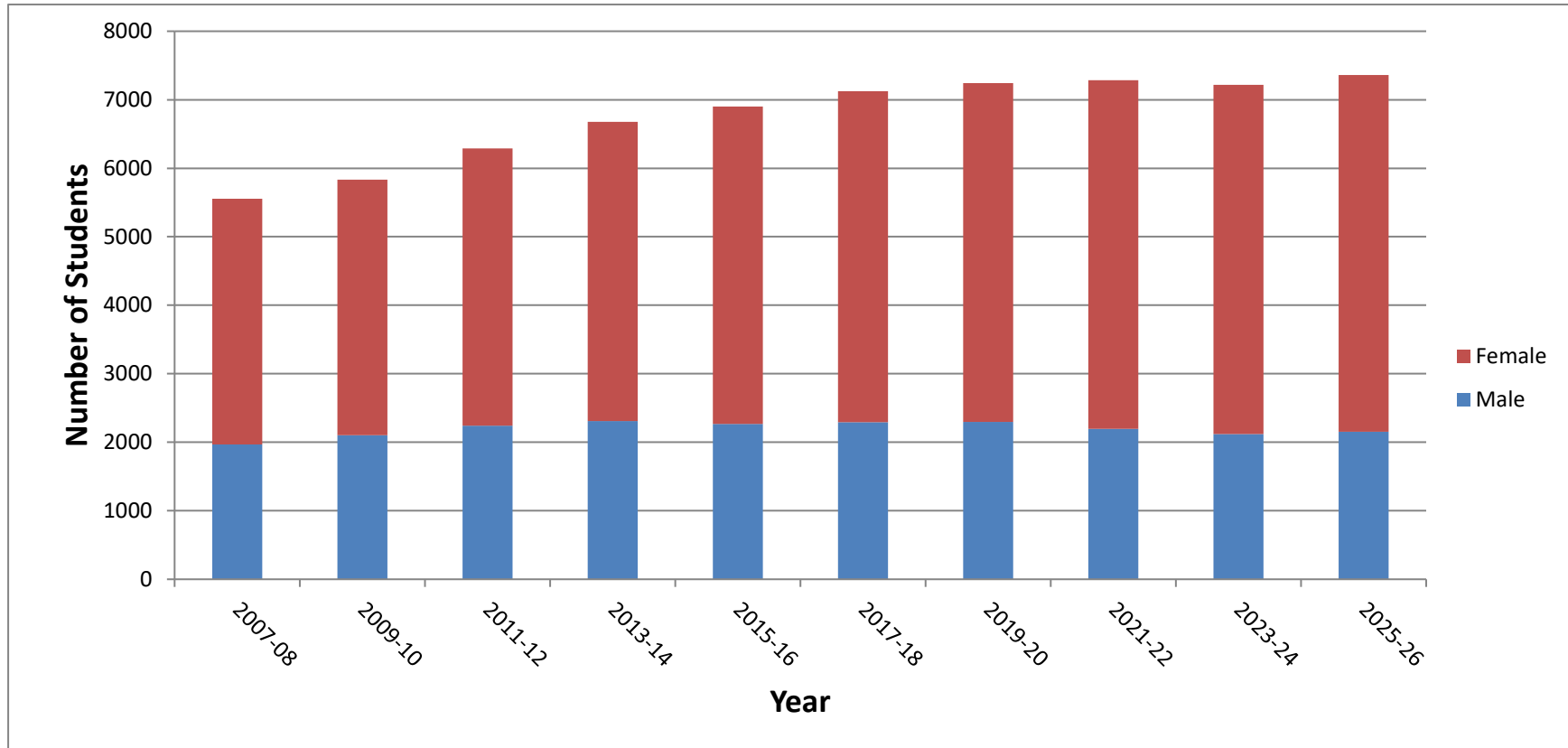
- In 2024-2025, the percentage of students receiving financial aid was 85.3%, up from 84.7% the previous year. The average award in 2024-2025 was \$56,950, down from \$58,051 in 2023-2024. (table 3.1)
- In 2025-2026, the average tuition for a first-year resident student enrolled in the professional O.D. program was \$31,531 at a public school and \$46,039 at a private school. The average cost for all direct expenses (tuition, fees, books and instruments) for a first-year resident student was \$39,881 for a public school and \$52,010 for a private school. First-year non-residents paid an average of \$48,158 for tuition and \$56,508 for all direct expenses at a public school, and \$46,981 for tuition and \$52,952 for all direct expenses at a private school. 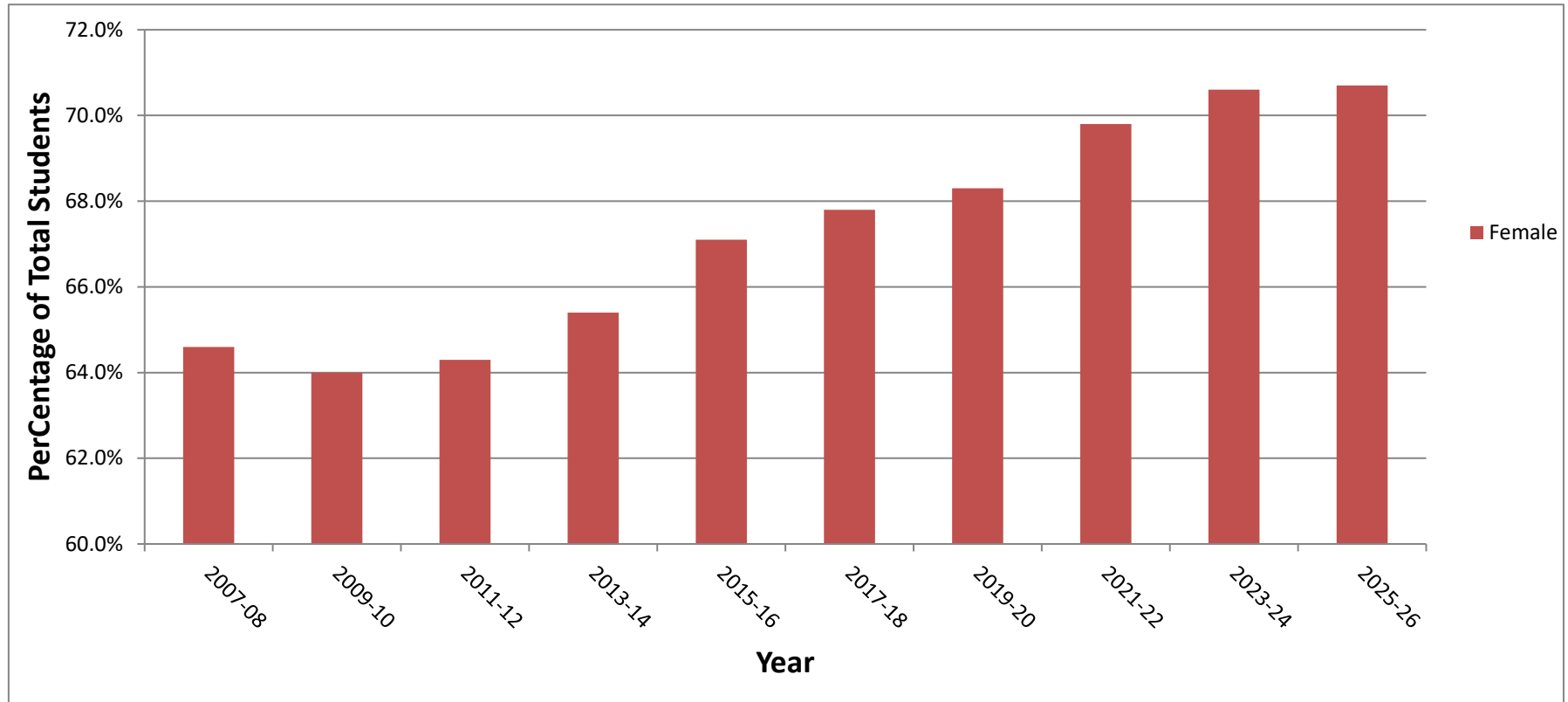

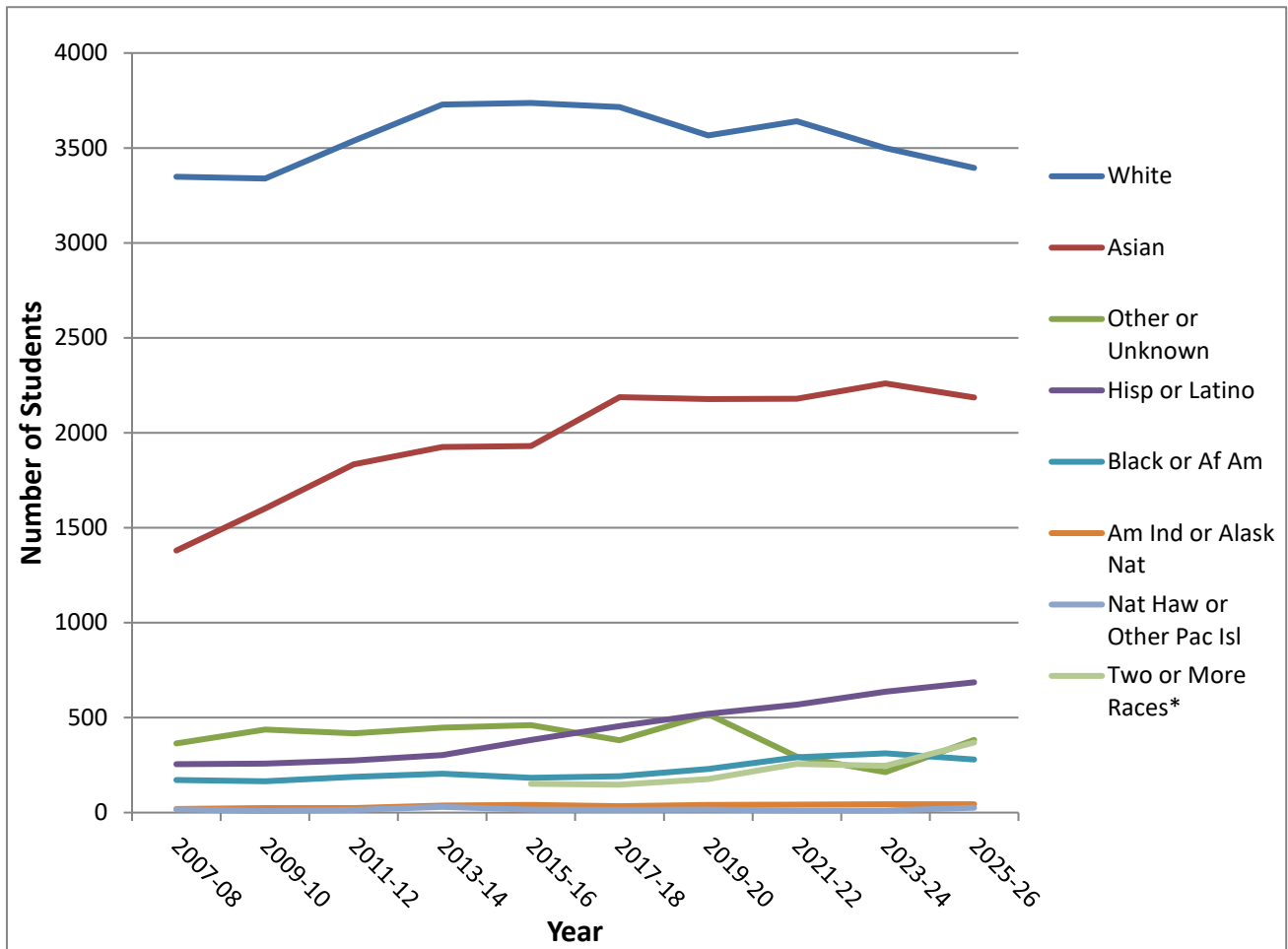

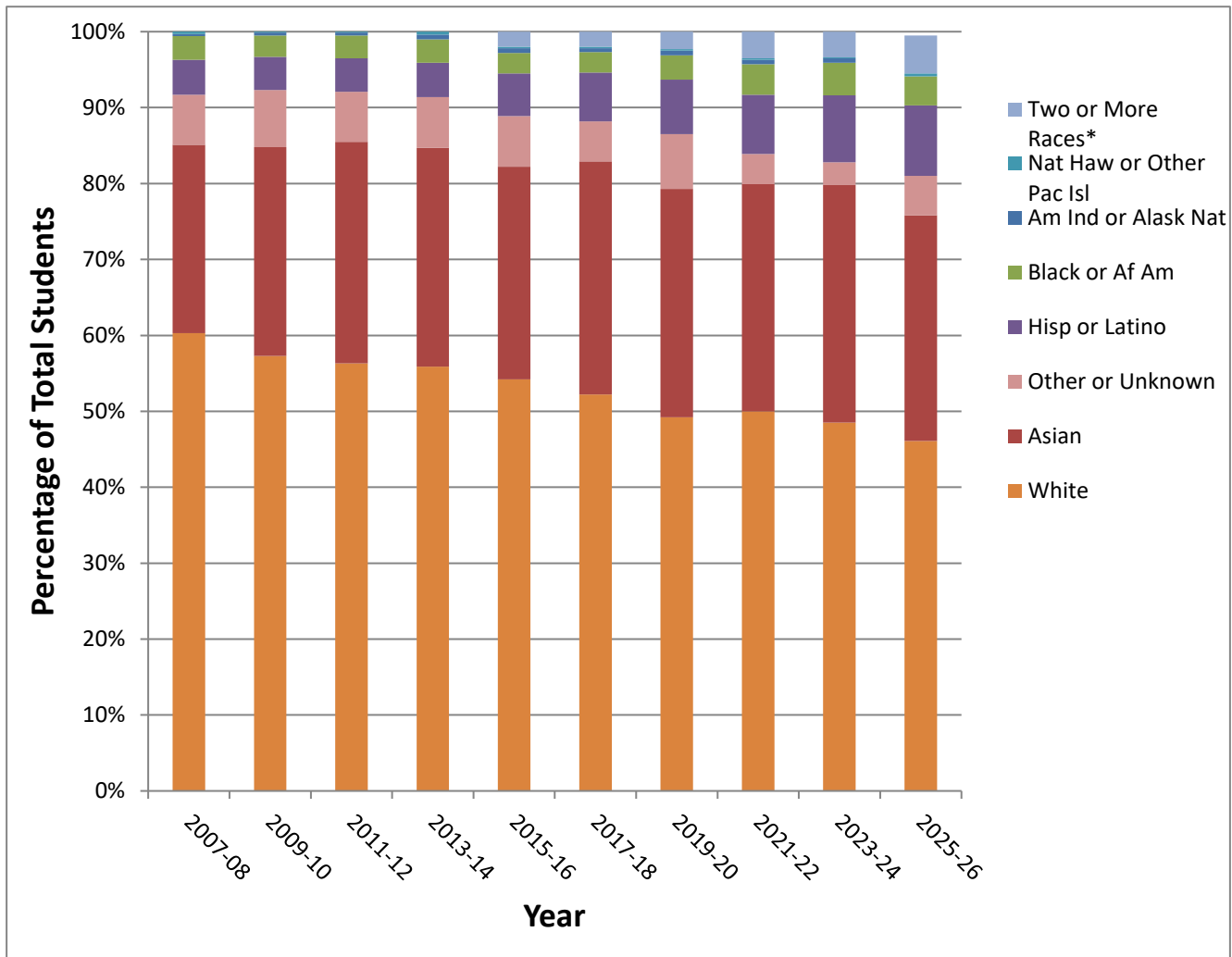

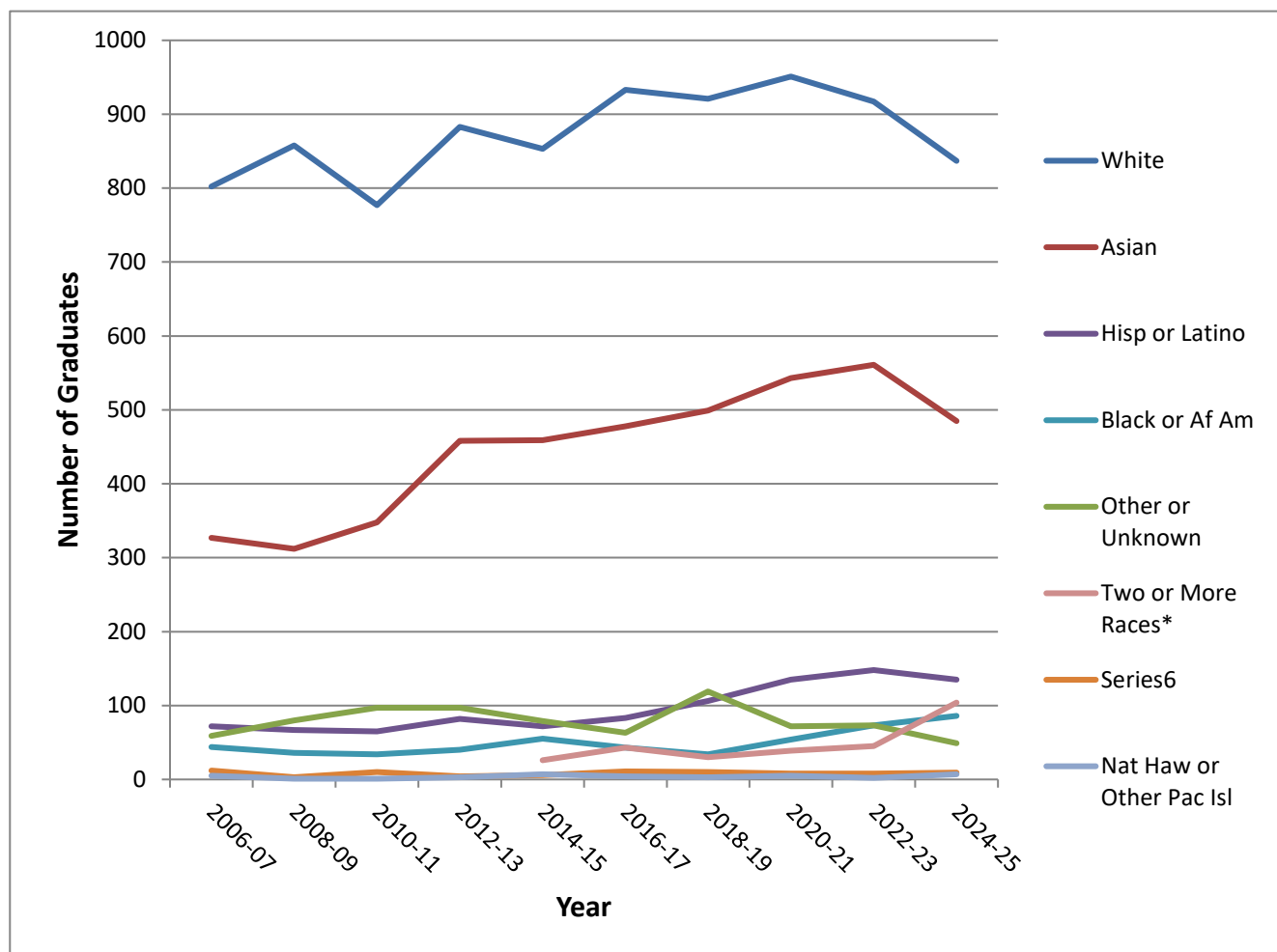

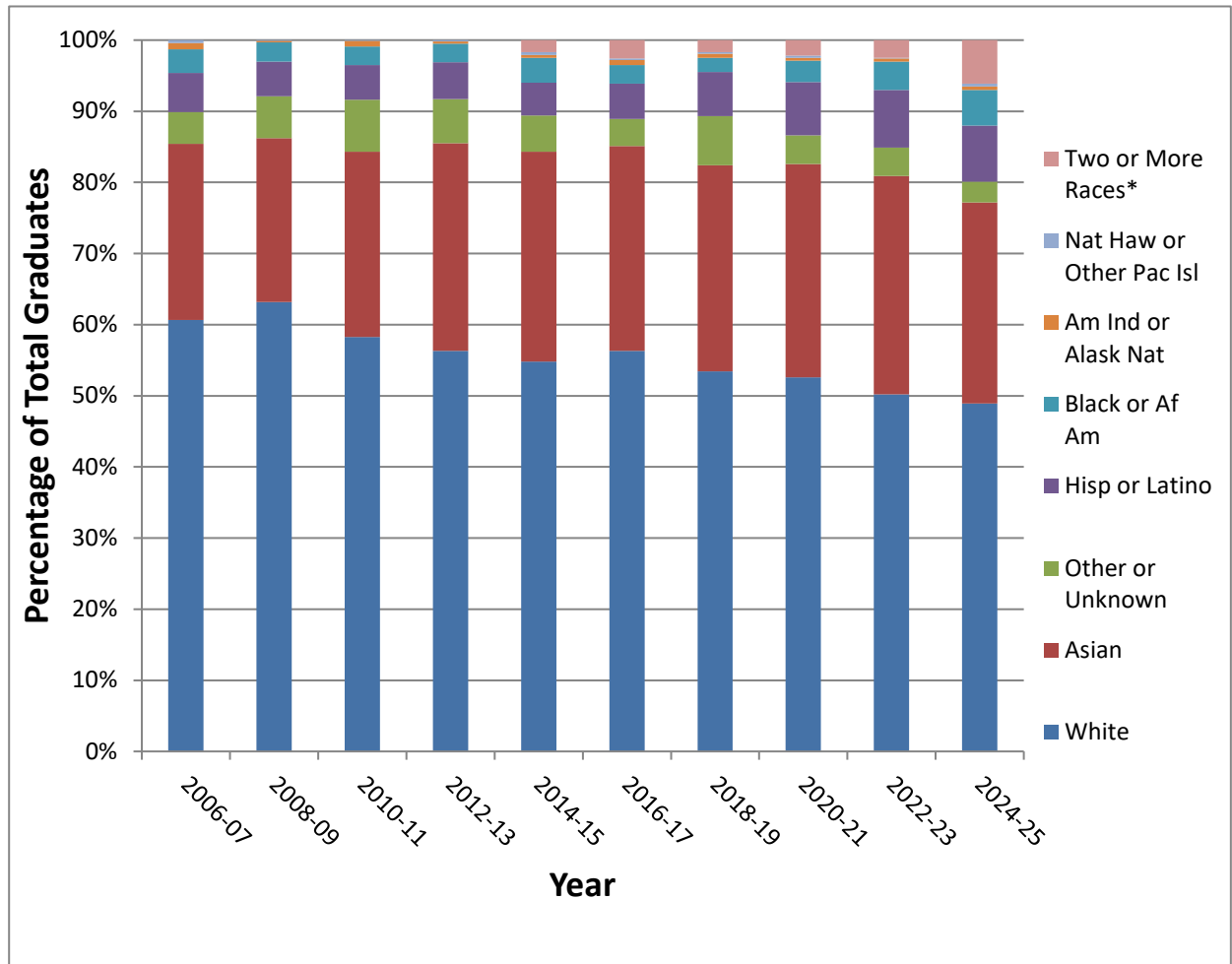
Race/Ethnicity of Graduates of Regular and Special OD Programs, 2006-2025

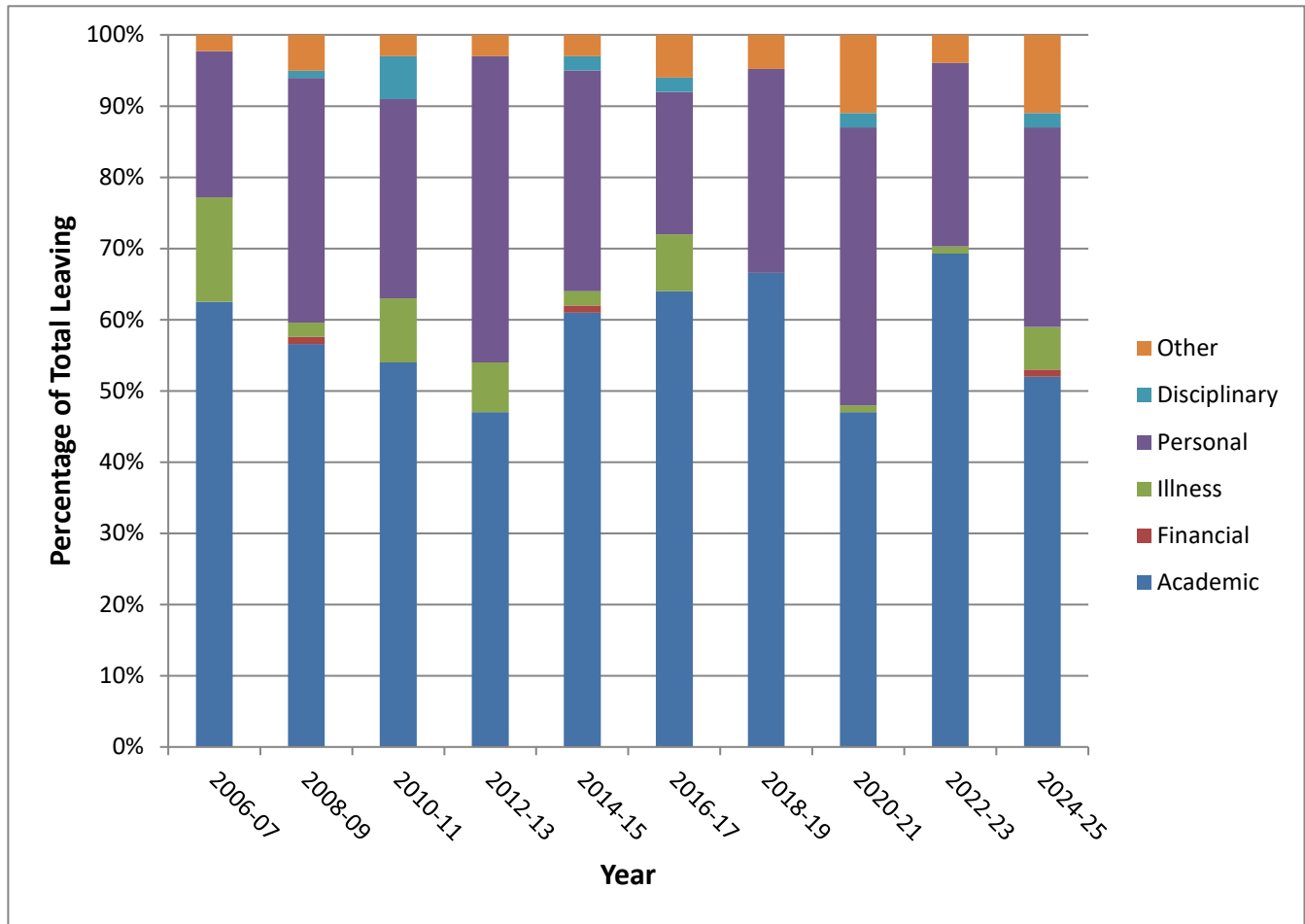

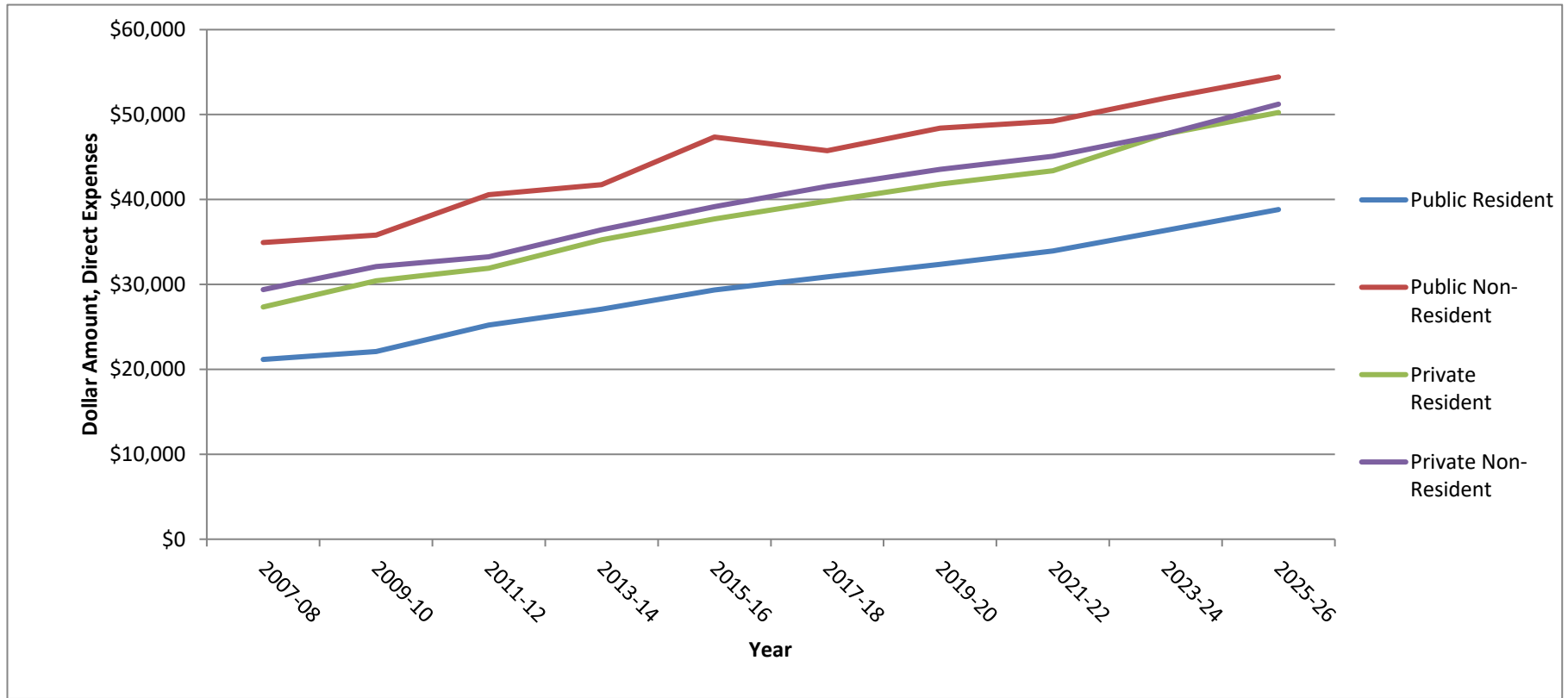

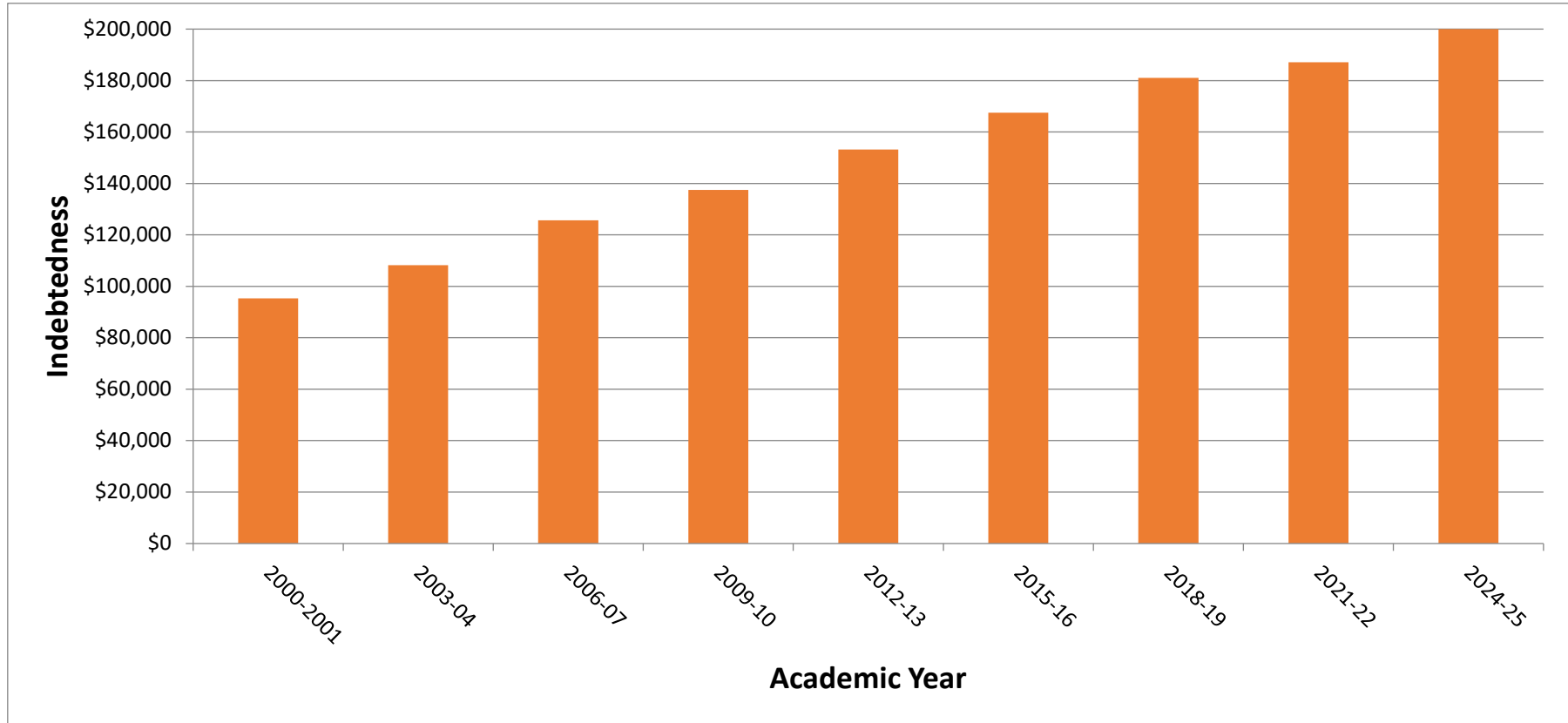

IUSO	<p>The Indiana University School of Optometry offers Advanced Placement into the OD program for individuals who have graduated from an accredited international optometry program, or who have graduated with an international medical degree. This program allows candidates to earn a Doctor of Optometry degree by giving them the opportunity to test out of didactic and clinic courses. Each applicant is assessed on an individual basis and an individual study plan will be created based on each applicant's experience and test results. Successful applicants could complete the four-year degree in as little as three years.</p>
NECO	<p>The Accelerated Optometric Degree Program, AODP, is an accelerated program for scientists and physicians who hold a doctoral degree in science or medicine (or equivalent experience). Applicants demonstrate high scholarship in previous graduate study, as well as a firm career commitment to optometry. The program was established in 1972 to attract highly qualified candidates who can provide unique contributions to the profession of optometry through teaching, research and clinical care. This program is designed to provide an accelerated education for qualified applicants with either an earned doctorate in one of the biological, behavioral, or physical sciences; or a doctoral-level health profession degree. Once admitted, AODP students follow an intense thirty-six month curriculum, which includes a full year of clinical rotations, engaging in full time patient care. Upon completion, graduates of the program are prepared to enter the profession in clinical practice, optometric education, or research.</p> <p>Through the College's Advanced Standing International Program (ASIP), graduates of international optometry programs may be admitted with advanced standing to the doctor of optometry degree program. ASIP students have to meet the same standards as the other program students, and reach the same competency standards in clinics in order to receive the Doctor of Optometry degree. Once admitted, ASIP students follow an intense two year curriculum, which includes one year of clinical externship rotations. Course work centers on basic sciences, disease, and advanced optometry skills and concepts.</p> <p>The MS/OD China Program is a unique joint degree program between Wenzhou Medical University (WMU) and the New England College of Optometry (NECO). Students who complete the program earn two degrees: the master of science and doctor of optometry degrees. The MS/OD China curriculum combines the AODP curriculum and the Master of Science degree with joint clinical externships that include six months in Boston-based rotations and six months at Wenzhou Medical University.</p>
